## What is the Writing Center?

The Writing Center provides free consulting services to all Mason writers, offering individual 45-minute appointments in person or online. If you opt for an online format, you can meet your writing consultant in real time on Zoom or submit your draft for your consultant's written feedback.

## What should I expect?

We work with writers at every stage of the process:

Planning	Revising
Brainstorming	Editing
Drafting	Polishing

A writing consultant can help you develop, clarify, and organize your ideas as well as share strategies and techniques for writing and revising. You can expect to leave your session with some good feedback, concrete strategies you can use in future writing assignments, and a plan for further developing or revising your draft.

## How do I make an appointment?
