- The LGBTQ+ Resources Center works to promote the academic success, health and well-being of queer, trans, non-binary, and/or questioning (LGBTQ+) students and their allies (including advising, advocacy, counseling and referral, education and training, group and workshop facilitation, and leadership development). We work to sustain and strengthen a campus climate of safety, equity, inclusion, and respect in which LGBTQ+ students can succeed and thrive at Mason.
- Offers a safe, open, welcoming space for all people interested in understanding LGBTQ+ issues; designed to promote both visibility and sense of community for all who wish to participate. The physical space is open to all students of all identities and students groups are welcome to use the space for meetings.
- Assists students in building communities of care, support, and trust; both within LGBTQ+ communities and across lines of gender, sexual and/or romantic orientation, race and ethnicity, culture, religion, ability, and other identity groups.
- Develops and conducts programs and co-curricular, educational, cultural, and social opportunities for students, faculty, and staff on LGBTQ+ issues.
- Provides consultation, education, technical assistance, training, and resources to faculty, staff, administration, Mason offices, and departments as well as others interested in ensuring that their services are inclusive and welcoming around LGBTQ+ issues.
